


Fig. 1 Power Derating Curve




Fig. 3 Typical DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current




Fig. 5 Typical Base Emitter Turn-On Voltage vs. Collector Current




Fig. 2 Typical Collector Current vs. Collector Emitter Voltage




Fig. 4 Typical Collector Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current






Fig. 6 Typical Base Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current







